Batch-Specific Documentation Adds Cost, and Value

Issuing an individual certificate of analysis for every production batch — rather than a single generic document reused across a product line — takes ongoing lab work. Suppliers that maintain this practice, such as through a dedicated [COA Vault](#), are pricing that transparency into the product.

Vial Size and Manufacturing Scale
