- An upholstered bed frame king size gives couples more room to stretch out and suits most standard UK main bedrooms.
- Super King A bed frame upholstered super king size is ideal for larger rooms and offers the most generous sleeping space available.

Always measure your room before ordering, allowing enough clearance around the bed for doors, wardrobes and general movement.



Budget vs Luxury What Changes?

- Detailing features like deep button tufting, piping and finished seams are typically found on designer upholstered bed frame options rather than entry level models.
